The bill modifies the eligibility requirement for certain State Teachers Retirement System (STRS) members who are allowed to seek election to the STRS Board. Under the bill, a retired teacher from STRS (called "superannuates") who is reemployed in a position covered by STRS is eligible to seek election to the Board as either a contributing member or a retired teacher member. The bill does not make any changes to the terms of or number of Board members serving on the bill's effective date.

The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. The bill does not make any changes to contribution rates to STRS. However, the bill may minimally affect the system's administrative costs related to elections to its Board.
