## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman Sean VanDenberg Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of S.R. 236 between S.R. 93, in Summit County, and Lafayette Drive, in Stark County
Other Information	Patrolman VanDenberg served with the Lawrence Township Police Department for eight years. He died from complications as a result of contracting COVID-19 from arresting and transporting a COVID-19 positive suspect to jail after serving a warrant.
