The bill does not appear to have a direct fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions. It prohibits municipal corporations from having a charter provision or ordinance that allows the legislative authority of that municipal corporation to engage in participatory budgeting. This would prohibit the legislative authority from appropriating, allocating, or drawing any moneys from the treasury to be disbursed by a vote of the residents. The bill also specifies that its provisions do not prohibit a municipal corporation from soliciting input from residents regarding the disbursement of funds. Finally, the bill declares an emergency and thus goes into immediate effect.
