#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 4511.454, 4511.455, and 4511.456	6
of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 4511.454. (A) There is hereby created in the	8
department of public safety the motorcycle road guard	9
certification program. The director of public safety shall	10
administer the program and shall adopt rules in accordance with	11
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code. The rules shall address or	12
establish all of the following:	13
(1) An application form to be used by applicants for a	14
motorcycle road guard certification;	15
(2) An application fee, which shall not exceed an amount	16
necessary for the department of public safety to administer the	17
motorcycle road guard certification program;	18

(3) A motorcycle road guard certification course that	19
provides the training required to serve as a motorcycle road	20
<pre>guard;</pre>	21
(4) The qualifications and requirements for receiving a	22
motorcycle road guard certificate, including a minimum	23
eligibility age of eighteen, possession of a driver's license	24
with a motorcycle endorsement or a motorcycle operator's	25
license, and successful completion of the motorcycle road guard	26
<pre>certification course;</pre>	27
(5) Safety and equipment standards and procedures for any	28
person who operates under a motorcycle road guard certificate;	29
(6) Any other requirements and procedures necessary to	30
implement the motorcycle road guard certification program.	31
(B) All fees received under division (A)(2) of this	32
section shall be deposited into the state treasury to the credit	33
of the state highway safety fund created by section 4501.06 of	34
the Revised Code. The department shall use all such fees only to	35
pay the expenses of administering the motorcycle road guard	36
certification program.	37
Sec. 4511.455. (A) Notwithstanding the contrary indication	38
of any traffic control device, a person who holds a motorcycle	39
road guard certificate issued pursuant to rules adopted under	40
section 4511.454 of the Revised Code may stop and hold vehicles	41
in place until it is safe for the vehicles to proceed if all of	42
the following apply:	43
(1) The person is escorting a motorcycle group ride;	44
(2) The person complies with the safety and equipment	45
standards established by the director of public safety under	46
section 4511.454 of the Revised Code;	47

(3) Notice has been provided to the mayor of any municipal	48
corporation or the legislative authority of any township through	4.9
which the motorcycle group ride will proceed;	50
(4) Consent has been obtained from the sheriff of any	51
county or the chief of police of any municipal corporation,	52

township, or township or joint police district through which the motorcycle group ride will proceed.	54
(B) No person shall perform traffic control functions as a	55
motorcycle road guard unless the person holds a valid motorcycle	56
road quard certificate issued under section 4511.454 of the	57
Revised Code and meets the requirements established under	58
division (A) of this section.	59
(C) No person operating a vehicle that has been stopped by	60
a motorcycle road guard under this section shall proceed unless	61
on instruction by the motorcycle road guard or a police officer.	62
(D) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor	63
misdemeanor. If, within one year of the offense, the offender	64
previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one	65
predicate motor vehicle or traffic offense, whoever violates	66
this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.	67
If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has	68
been convicted of two or more predicate motor vehicle or traffic	69
offenses, whoever violates this section is guilty of a	70
misdemeanor of the third degree.	71
Sec. 4511.456. (A) A person who performs traffic control	72
as a motorcycle road guard is not liable in damages in a civil	73
action for injury, death, or loss to person or property that	74
allegedly arises from the movement of a motorcycle group ride if	75
the person complies with all applicable rules adopted under	76

section 4511.454 of the Revised Code and with the requirements	77
of section 4511.455 of the Revised Code.	78
(B)(1) This section does not apply if the injury, death,	79
(b) (1) This becefor does not apply if the injury, acath,	
or loss allegedly arose from any of the following:	80
(a) The willful, wanton, or intentional acts or omissions	81
of the person who performs traffic control as a motorcycle road	82
guard;	
(b) The negligent or reckless acts or omissions of the	84
person who performs traffic control as a motorcycle road guard.	85
(2) This section does not create a new cause of action or	86
substantive legal right against a person who performs traffic	87
control as a motorcycle road guard.	88
(3) This section does not affect any immunities from civil	89
liability or defenses established by another section of the	90
Revised Code or any immunities from civil liability or defenses	91
available at common law to which a person may be entitled.	92
