A BILL

To enact section 4301.71 of the Revised Code to 1
prohibit the sale of powdered or crystalline 2
alcohol for human consumption. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4301.71 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 4301.71. (A) No person shall sell or offer for sale 6
powdered or crystalline alcohol for human consumption. 7

(B) Division (A) of this section does not apply to any of 8
the following: 9

(1) Any substance regulated by the food and drug 10
administration in the United States department of health and 11
human services that is not either of the following: 12

(a) Beer or intoxicating liquor; or 13

(b) A compound that could be converted into beer or 14

<u>intoxicating liquor.</u>	15
<u>(2) A medication that requires a prescription;</u>	16
<u>(3) An over-the-counter medication.</u>	17
<u>(C) As used in this section:</u>	18
<u>(1) "Powdered or crystalline alcohol" means a product that</u>	19
<u>is manufactured into a powdered or crystalline form and that</u>	20
<u>contains any amount of alcohol.</u>	21
<u>(2) "Prescription" has the same meaning as in section</u>	22
<u>4729.01 of the Revised Code.</u>	23
<u>(3) "Over-the-counter medication" means medication that</u>	24
<u>may be legally sold and purchased without a prescription.</u>	25
