То	amend sections 4511.132 and 4511.27 of the	1
	Revised Code to provide that when a motor	2
	vehicle passes a bicycle the safe passing	3
	distance to the left is three feet or greater,	4
	and to alter the protocol for proceeding into an	5
	intersection that has malfunctioning traffic	6
	lights.	7

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 4511.132 and 4511.27 of the	8
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	9
Sec. 4511.132. (A) The driver of a vehicle, streetcar, or	10
trackless trolley who approaches an intersection where traffic	11
is controlled by traffic control signals shall do all of the	12
following if the signal facing the driver either exhibits no	13

proceeding in the same direction:

- (1) The operator of a vehicle or trackless trolley overtaking another vehicle or trackless trolley proceeding in the same direction shall, except as provided in division (A)(3) of this section, signal to the vehicle or trackless trolley to be overtaken, shall pass to the left thereof at a safe distance, and shall not again drive to the right side of the roadway until safely clear of the overtaken vehicle or trackless trolley. When a motor vehicle or trackless trolley overtakes and passes a bicycle, three feet or greater is considered a safe passing distance.
- (2) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is permitted, the operator of an overtaken vehicle shall give way to the right in favor of the overtaking vehicle at the latter's audible signal, and the operator shall not increase the speed of the operator's vehicle until completely passed by the overtaking vehicle.
- (3) The operator of a vehicle or trackless trolley overtaking and passing another vehicle or trackless trolley proceeding in the same direction on a divided highway as defined in section 4511.35 of the Revised Code, a limited access highway as defined in section 5511.02 of the Revised Code, or a highway with four or more traffic lanes, is not required to signal audibly to the vehicle or trackless trolley being overtaken and passed.
- (B) Except as otherwise provided in this division, whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one predicate motor vehicle or traffic offense, whoever violates this section is guilty of a

offense, the offender previously has been convicted of two or	74
more predicate motor vehicle or traffic offenses, whoever	75
violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third	76
degree.	77
Section 2. That existing sections 4511.132 and 4511.27 of	78
the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	79
