A BILL

To enact sections 317.241 and 317.242 of the 1
Revised Code to authorize a county recorder or 2
county veterans service office, with the 3
approval of the board of county commissioners, 4
to issue Ohio veterans identification cards. 5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 317.241 and 317.242 of the 6
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 7

Sec. 317.241. (A) The board of county commissioners may by 8

resolution allow the county recorder or county veterans service 9
office to issue Ohio veterans identification cards to 10
individuals who have met the following requirements: 11

(1) Presented the individual's armed forces discharge 12
record for recording in the record of discharges in the office 13
of the county recorder; 14

(2) Provided, while appearing in person at a county 15
recorder's office or county veterans service office, two forms 16
of current and valid identification, at least one of which bears 17
a photograph of the individual; 18

(3) Paid a fee, if a fee has been established by the 19
county. 20

A board of county commissioners may, by resolution, 21
authorize a county recorder or county veterans service office to 22
collect a fee from individuals requesting a veterans 23
identification card. The fee may not exceed two dollars. 24

If a county veterans service office maintains access to 25
the state and federal military service verification system, the 26
county veterans service office or county recorder, by consulting 27
the county veterans service office, shall confirm before issuing 28
a veterans identification card that the individual's armed 29
forces discharge record exists in the system's database and does 30
not indicate the individual was dishonorably discharged. 31

(B) A county recorder or county veterans service office 32
who has in operation, before the effective date of this section, 33
a program to issue veterans identification cards may continue to 34
issue veterans identification cards without a resolution of the 35
board of county commissioners, if the county recorder or county 36
veterans service office conforms the program, as necessary, so 37
that it otherwise is in compliance with this section. 38

(C) An Ohio veterans identification card expires ten years 39

after the date of issuance. A veteran whose identification card 40
has expired may apply to a county recorder or county veterans 41
service office for the issuance of a new identification card, 42
and a veteran whose current card has been lost or damaged may 43
apply to a county recorder or county veterans service office for 44
a replacement identification card, by meeting the requirements 45
described in this section. 46

(D) The following documents are valid forms of 47
identification for the purposes of this section: 48

(1) An original or a certified birth certificate; 49

(2) An identification card issued by the United States 50
department of veterans affairs; 51

(3) A United States military identification card; 52

(4) A social security card; 53

(5) A license or permit to carry a concealed weapon issued 54
by this state or any other state; 55

(6) A motor vehicle operator's license issued by this 56
state or any other state that bears a photograph of the 57
licensee; 58

(7) An identification card issued by this state or any 59
other state that bears a photograph of the individual 60
identified; 61

(8) A valid passport that bears a photograph of the 62
individual to whom the passport was issued; 63

(9) A United States armed forces discharge record. 64

(E) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited 65
into the county treasury to the credit of the county general 66
fund. 67

(F) (1) An Ohio veterans identification card shall conform 68

to the material and design standards established by the Ohio 69
recorders association in consultation with the county 70
commissioners' association of Ohio and Ohio state association of 71
county veterans service officers. All issuing entities shall 72
follow the design standards established pursuant to Sec. 73
317.242. 74

(2) An applicant for an Ohio veterans identification card 75
shall be photographed in color at the time the application for 76
the card is made. A county recorder or county veterans service 77
office that issues identification cards shall provide the 78
necessary equipment to take a color photograph of an applicant 79
for an Ohio veterans identification card. Photographic records 80
of a county recorder's office or county veterans service office 81
that are obtained under this section are the property of the 82
county recorder's office or county veterans service office. 83

(G) All application materials, including applications, 84
photographs, documents, or other information submitted with an 85
application or obtained by a county recorder or county veterans 86
service office are not public records under section 149.43 of 87
the Revised Code. The county recorder or county veterans service 88
office may only release application materials as follows: 89

(1) To a state, local, or federal governmental agency for 90
criminal justice purposes or to a court for any purpose arising 91
in the court; 92

(2) To the department of veterans services, but only if 93
the veteran gives prior signed written approval; 94

(3) To a county veterans service commission, but only if 95
the veteran gives prior signed written approval. 96

A governmental agency, a court, the department of veterans 97
services, or a county veterans service commission to which 98
application materials have been released shall maintain the 99
confidentiality of those materials. 100

(H) A county recorder or county veterans service office 101
may contract with any other political subdivision of the state 102
for Ohio veterans identification card production services. 103

(I) A county recorder or county veterans service office 104
may accept donations, in the form of supplies and equipment, to 105
be used in the production of Ohio veterans identification cards. 106

Sec. 317.242. The Ohio recorders association, in 107
consultation with the county commissioners' association of Ohio 108
and Ohio state association of county veteran service officers, 109
shall establish material and design standards for Ohio veterans 110
identification cards that may be issued by county recorders or 111
county veterans service offices. 112

The material and design standards shall require that an 113
Ohio identification card include the name of this state, a 114
distinguishing number assigned to the cardholder, a color 115
photograph of the cardholder, the cardholder's name and 116
residence address, the cardholder's branch of service, dates of 117
service, and date of discharge, the name of the issuing county, 118
the indexing number that has been assigned to the veteran's 119
record of discharge, and the date of the card's issuance and 120
expiration. 121

An Ohio veterans identification card shall not display the 122
cardholder's social security number unless federal law requires 123
the cardholder's social security number to be displayed on a 124
veterans identification card. 125

Section 2. Not later than six months after the effective 126
date of this act, the Ohio Records Association, in 127
consultation with the County Commissioners' Association of Ohio 128
and the Ohio State Association of County Veteran Service 129
Officers, shall establish initial material and design standards 130
for Ohio veterans identification cards, as required by section 131
317.242 of the Revised Code. 132
