BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.97 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to	9
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.496,	10
4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 4503.505,	11
4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526,	12

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the	19

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state.

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 144 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 145 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 146 source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 147 designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. (C) All investment earnings of the license plate	335
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than	336
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall	337
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this	338

section the investment income the fund earned the previous	339
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an	340
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity	341
received from the fund during the previous calendar year.	342
Sec. 4503.97. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger	343
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other	344
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles	345
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle	346
and issuance of "I Stand with Israel" license plates. The	347
application may be combined with a request for a special	348
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the	349
Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and	350
compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this	351
section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the	352
appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "I Stand with	353
Israel" license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation	354
sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised	355
Code.	356
In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily	357
inscribed on the license plates, "I Stand with Israel" license	358
plates shall be inscribed with identifying words or markings	359
that are designed by the friends of united Hatzalah of Israel,	360
and approved by the registrar. "I Stand with Israel" license	361
plates shall display county identification stickers that	362
identify the county of registration by name or number.	363
(B) "I Stand with Israel" license plates and a validation	364
sticker, or validation sticker alone, shall be issued upon	365
receipt of an application for registration of a motor vehicle	366
under this section; payment of the regular license tax as	367
prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any	368

applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504.	369
of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee prescribed by	370
section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, a bureau of	371
motor vehicles administrative fee of ten dollars, and a	372
contribution as provided in division (C) of this section; and	373

(C) For each application for registration and registration	376
renewal notice the registrar receives under this section, the	377
registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty dollars. The	378
registrar shall transmit this contribution to the treasurer of	379
state for deposit into the state treasury to the credit of the	380
license plate contribution fund created by section 4501.21 of	381
the Revised Code.	382
The registrar shall transmit the bureau of motor vehicles	383
administrative fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to	384
compensate the bureau for the additional services required in	385
the issuing of "I Stand with Israel" license plates, to the	386
treasurer of state for deposit into the state treasury to the	387
credit of the state bureau of motor vehicles fund created by	388
section 4501.25 of the Revised Code.	389
Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised	390
Code is hereby repealed.	391
