A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1
4503.495 of the Revised Code to create the 2
"Pancreatic Cancer Awareness" license plate. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section 4
4503.495 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 9
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 10
4503.496, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 11
4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 12
4503.526, 4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 13
4503.552, 4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 14
4503.576, 4503.591, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 15
4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.72, 4503.73, 16
4503.732, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.89, 17
4503.90, 4503.92, and 4503.94 of the Revised Code. 18

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 19
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 20

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 21
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 22
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 23
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 24
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 25
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 26
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 27
other abortion-related activities. 28

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 29
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 30
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 31
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 32
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 33
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 34
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 35
other money in that fund. 36

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 37
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 38
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 39
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 40

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 41
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 42
national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 43
amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 44
chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 45
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 46
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 47
directly to their clients. 48

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 49
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 50
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 51
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 52
pancreatic cancer and their families. 53

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 54
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 55
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 56
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 57
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 58

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 59
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 60
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 61
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 62

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 63
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 64
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 65
contributions for its research and other programs. 66

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 67
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 68
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 69
contributions into its general account to be used for 70
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 71
America foundation. 72

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 73
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 74
4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 75
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 76
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 77

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 78
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 79
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 80
scholarships and other educational activities. 81

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 82
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 83
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 84
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 85
that organization. 86

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 87
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 88
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 89
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 90
section. A university or college that receives contributions 91
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 92
scholarship fund. 93

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 94
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 95
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 96
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 97
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 98
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 99
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 100

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 101
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 102
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 103
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 104
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 105

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 106

receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 107
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 108
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 109
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 110

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 111
receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 112
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 113
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 114
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 115
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 116
sponsors within this state. 117

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 118
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 119
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 120
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 121
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 122
activities. 123

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 124
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 125
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 126
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 127
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 128
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 129
personnel, veterans, and their families. 130

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 131
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 132
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 133
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 134
families. 135

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel destination.

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state.

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and cats and for educational programs concerning the proper veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit

corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 166
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 167
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 168
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 169
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 170
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 171
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 172
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 173
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 174
under this section. 175

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 176
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 177
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 178
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 179
programs. 180

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 181
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 182
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 183
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 184
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 185
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 186
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 187
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 188
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 189
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 190
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 191
such payments are to be made. 192

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 193
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 194
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 195

expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 196
river watershed. 197

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 198
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 199
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 200
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 201

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 202
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 203
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 204
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 205
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 206
local beekeeping programs. 207

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 208
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 209
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 210
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 211
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 212
commission and that is participating in the license plate 213
program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 214
of the county of residence of an applicant. 215

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each 216
contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of 217
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates 218
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is 219
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 220
(G) of that section. 221

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 222
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 223
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 224

shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 225
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 226

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 227
receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 228
great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 229
America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 230
equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 231
the girl scouts. 232

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 233
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 234
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 235
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 236
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 237

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 238
receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 239
Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 240
which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 241

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 242
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 243
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 244
deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 245
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 246

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 247
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 248
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 249
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 250
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 251
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 252
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 253

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 254
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 255
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 256
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 257
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 258
in the line of duty. 259

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 260
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 261
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 262
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 263
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 264

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 265
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 266
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 267
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 268
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 269
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 270
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 271
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 272
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 273
participating in that program. 274

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 275
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 276
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 277
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 278
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 279

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 280
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 281
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 282
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 283

Cleveland, Ohio. 284

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 285
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 286
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 287
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 288
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 289
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 290

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 291
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 292
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 293
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 294
used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 295
rotary foundation. 296

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 297
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 298
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 299
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 300
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 301

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 302
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 303
Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 304
research projects. 305

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 306
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 307
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 308
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 309
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 310
state. 311

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 312

receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 313
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 314
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 315
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 316
programs on a statewide basis. 317

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 318
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 319
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 320

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 321
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 322
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 323
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 324
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 325
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 326
financial need. 327

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 328
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 329
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 330
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 331
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 332
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 333
vocational school districts. 334

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 335
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 336
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 337
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 338
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 339
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 340
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 341
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 342

Sec. 4503.495. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 343
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 344
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 345
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 346
and issuance of pancreatic cancer awareness license plates. An 347
application made under this section may be combined with a 348
request for a special reserved license plate under section 349
4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the 350
completed application and compliance by the applicant with 351
divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the registrar shall issue 352
to the applicant the appropriate vehicle registration and a set 353
of pancreatic cancer awareness license plates and a validation 354
sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required by section 355
4503.191 of the Revised Code. 356

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 357
inscribed on the license plates, pancreatic cancer awareness 358
license plates shall be inscribed with identifying words or 359
markings that promote pancreatic cancer awareness and are 360
approved by the registrar. Pancreatic cancer awareness license 361
plates shall display county identification stickers that 362
identify the county of registration by name or number. 363

(B) Pancreatic cancer awareness license plates and a 364
validation sticker, or validation sticker alone, shall be issued 365
upon receipt of a contribution as provided in division (C) of 366
this section and upon payment of the regular license tax as 367
prescribed under section 4503.04, any applicable motor vehicle 368
license tax levied under Chapter 4504. of the Revised Code, any 369
applicable additional fee prescribed by section 4503.40 or 370
4503.42 of the Revised Code, a bureau of motor vehicles 371
administrative fee of ten dollars, and compliance with all other 372
applicable laws relating to the registration of motor vehicles. 373

(C) For each application for registration and registration 374
renewal notice the registrar receives under this section, the 375
registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty-five dollars. 376
The registrar shall transmit this contribution to the treasurer 377
of state for deposit in the license plate contribution fund 378
created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code. 379

The registrar shall transmit the administrative fee of ten 380
dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the bureau for 381
the additional services required in the issuing of pancreatic 382
cancer awareness license plates, to the treasurer of state for 383
deposit into the state treasury to the credit of the state 384
bureau of motor vehicles fund created by section 4501.25 of the 385
Revised Code. 386

Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 387
Code is hereby repealed. 388
