Section 1. That section 4121.351 of the Revised Code is	9

The foregoing appropriation item 845402, Rent - William Green 27 Building, shall be used for rent and operating expenses for the 28 space occupied by the Industrial Commission in the William Green 29 Building. 30

Section 3. Law contained in the main operating appropriations 31 act of the 131st General Assembly that applies generally to the 32 appropriations made in that act also applies generally to the 33 appropriations made in this act. 34

Section 4. The provisions of law contained in this act, and 35 their applications, are severable. If any provision of law 36 contained in this act, or if any application of any provision of 37 law contained in this act, is held invalid, the invalidity does 38 not affect other provisions of law contained in this act and their 39 applications that can be given effect without the invalid 40 provision or application. 41

Section 5. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this 42 act, the sections of law contained in this act, and the items of 43 law of which the sections of law contained in this act are 44 composed, are not subject to the referendum under Ohio 45 Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and section 1.471 of the 46 Revised Code and therefore go into immediate effect when this act 47 becomes law. 48

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Section 6. The amendment, enactment, or repeal by this act of	49
the divisions and sections of law listed below are subject to the	50
referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 1c and	51
therefore take effect on the ninety-first day after this act is	52
filed with the Secretary of State:	53
