A BILL

To enact section 3501.45 of the Revised Code to
create a presumption of validity for certain
election matters and to require certain
provisional ballots cast in the wrong polling
place to be remade and counted.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3501.45 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 3501.45. (A) Notwithstanding any provision of the
Revised Code to the contrary, voter registration applications,
applications for absent voter's ballots, absent voter's ballot
identification statements of voter, absent voter's ballots,
provisional ballot affirmations, provisional ballots, and
regular ballots shall be presumed valid unless proven otherwise.
Errors, misspellings, and omissions of printed material that do
not render it impossible for a board of elections to determine
who applied for registration, who applied for absent voter's
ballots, who cast absent voter's ballots, a provisional ballot,
or a regular ballot, or what selections or write-in votes were

made on a ballot are immaterial and shall not disqualify an 19
application for registration, an application for absent voter's 20
ballots, a regular, provisional, or absent voter's ballot, or a 21
selection or write-in choice on a ballot. 22

(B) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the Revised Code 23
to the contrary, except as otherwise provided in division (B) (2) 24
of this section, if an individual casts a provisional ballot in 25
a polling place other than the polling place assigned to the 26
precinct in which the individual is registered and eligible to 27
vote, the provisional ballot shall be remade on a ballot for the 28
appropriate precinct to reflect the offices, questions, and 29
issues for which the individual was eligible to cast a ballot 30
and for which the individual attempted to cast a provisional 31
ballot. The remade ballot shall be counted for each office, 32
question, and issue for which the individual was eligible to 33
vote. 34

(2) A provisional ballot described in division (B) (1) of 35
this section shall not be counted if a precinct election 36
official produces clear evidence that the precinct election 37
official determined the individual's correct precinct and 38
directed the individual to that precinct. 39
