BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3302.036 be amended and section	11
3301.0728 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	12
Sec. 3301.0728. Notwithstanding anything in the Revised	13
Code to the contrary, at any time in a student's academic	14
career, a student may retake any end-of-course examination	15
prescribed under division (B)(2) of section 3301.0712 of the	16
Revised Code. If, for any reason, a student does not take an	17
end-of-course examination on the scheduled administration date,	18
the department of education shall make available to the student	19

the examination for which the student was absent so that the	20
student may take the examination at a later time in the	21
student's academic career. The state board of education shall	22
adopt rules in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code	23
to implement the provisions of this section.	24

25 Sec. 3302.036. (A) Notwithstanding anything in the Revised 26 Code to the contrary, the department of education shall not 27 assign an overall letter grade under division (C)(3) of section 28 3302.03 of the Revised Code for any school district or building for the 2014-2015 school year, may, at the discretion of the 29 30 state board of education, not assign an individual grade to any component prescribed under division (C)(3) of section 3302.03 of 31 the Revised Code, and shall not rank school districts, community 32 33 schools established under Chapter 3314. of the Revised Code, or STEM schools established under Chapter 3326. of the Revised Code 34 under section 3302.21 of the Revised Code for that school year. 35 The report card ratings issued for the 2014-2015 school year 36 shall not be considered in determining whether a school district 37 or a school is subject to sanctions or penalties. However, the 38 39 report card ratings of any previous or subsequent years shall be considered in determining whether a school district or building 40 is subject to sanctions or penalties. Accordingly, the report 41 card ratings for the 2014-2015 school year shall have no effect 42 43 in determining sanctions or penalties, but shall not create a 44 new starting point for determinations that are based on ratings 45 over multiple years.

Section 4. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	97
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	98
peace, health, and safety. The reason for the necessity is that	99

and secondary achievement assessments for the 2014-2015 school	102
year. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.	103
