**A BILL**

To enact section 5534.27 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate a portion of State Route 73 in Butler 2  
County as the "SPC James E. Hall Jr. Memorial 3  
Highway." 4

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5534.27 of the Revised Code be 5  
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 5534.27. In addition to any other name prescribed in 7  
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 8  
state route number seventy-three, commencing at the intersection 9  
of that route and Jacksonburg road and proceeding in an easterly 10  
direction to the intersection of that route and Wehr road, 11  
within Butler county only, shall be known as the "SPC James E. 12  
Hall, Jr. Memorial Highway." 13

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 14  
along the highway indicating its name. 15
