A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1
4503.556 of the Revised Code to create the 2
"Triple Negative Breast Cancer Awareness" 3
license plate. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section 5
4503.556 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 7
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 8
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 9
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 10
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 11
4503.496, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 4503.502, 12
4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 13
4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 14
4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.555, 15
4503.556, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.576, 16
4503.577, 4503.591, 4503.592, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 17
4503.701, 4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 18

4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 19
4503.763, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.87, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.902, 20
4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, and 4503.97 of the Revised 21
Code. 22

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 23
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 24

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 25
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 26
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 27
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 28
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 29
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 30
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 31
other abortion-related activities. 32

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 33
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 34
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 35
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 36
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 37
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 38
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 39
other money in that fund. 40

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 41
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 42
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 43
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 44

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 45
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 46
national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 47

amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 48
chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 49
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 50
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 51
directly to their clients. 52

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 53
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 54
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 55
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 56
pancreatic cancer and their families. 57

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 58
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 59
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 60
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 61
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 62

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 63
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 64
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 65
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 66

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 67
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 68
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 69
contributions for its research and other programs. 70

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 71
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 72
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 73
contributions into its general account to be used for 74
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 75
America foundation. 76

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for scholarships and other educational activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those contributions for scholarships for students who are members of that organization.

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the university or college whose name or marking or design appears on collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that section. A university or college that receives contributions from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general scholarship fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of this state, to assist that organization in paying the expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, educational, and cultural events at the monument.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 106
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 107
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 108
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 109

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 110
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 111
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 112
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 113
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 114

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 115
receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 116
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 117
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 118
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 119
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 120
sponsors within this state. 121

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 122
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 123
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 124
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 125
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 126
activities. 127

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 128
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 129
Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 130
money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 131
incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 132
provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 133
this state. 134

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it receives under this section to provide educational scholarships to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance their education, and to support persons conducting nursing research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and the improvement of patient outcomes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of this state, to assist that organization in paying for the charitable activities and programs it sponsors in support of United States military personnel, veterans, and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for programs that serve disabled American veterans and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel destination.

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to

the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 165
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 166
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 167
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 168

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 169
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 170
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 171
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 172
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 173
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 174
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 175
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 176
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 177
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 178
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 179

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 180
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 181
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 182

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 183
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 184
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 185
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 186
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 187
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 188
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 189
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 190
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 191
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 192
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 193
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 194

under this section. 195

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 196
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 197
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 198
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 199
programs. 200

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 201
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 202
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 203
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 204

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 205
receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the 206
Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple 207
negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the 208
contributions for charitable and educational purposes. 209

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 210
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 211
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 212
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 213
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 214
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 215
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 216
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 217
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 218
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 219
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 220
such payments are to be made. 221

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 222
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 223

Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 224
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 225
river watershed. 226

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 227
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 228
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 229
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 230

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 231
receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 232
conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 233
the money in support of the park. 234

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 235
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 236
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 237
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 238
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 239
local beekeeping programs. 240

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 241
receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 242
national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 243
contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 244
legends to inspire future leaders. 245

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 246
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 247
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 248
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 249
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 250
commission and that is participating in the license plate 251
program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 252

of the county of residence of an applicant.	253
The registrar shall pay to a community charity each	254
contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of	255
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates	256
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is	257
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division	258
(G) of that section.	259
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	260
receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to	261
monarch wings across Ohio, which shall use the contributions for	262
the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and	263
pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs.	264
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	265
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the	266
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council	267
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner	268
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.	269
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	270
receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the	271
great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of	272
America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an	273
equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of	274
the girl scouts.	275
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	276
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the	277
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council	278
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner	279
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.	280
The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar	281

receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 282
Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 283
which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 284

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 285
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 286
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 287
deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 288
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 289

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 290
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 291
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 292
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 293
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 294
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 295
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 296

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 297
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 298
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 299
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 300
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 301
in the line of duty. 302

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 303
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 304
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 305
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 306
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 307

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 308
receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 309
fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 310

to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 311
families. 312

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 313
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 314
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 315
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 316
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 317
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 318
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 319
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 320
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 321
participating in that program. 322

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 323
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 324
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 325
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 326
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 327

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 328
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 329
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 330
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 331
Cleveland, Ohio. 332

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 333
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 334
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 335
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 336
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 337
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 338

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 339

receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 340
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 341
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 342
used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 343
rotary foundation. 344

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 345
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 346
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 347
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 348
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 349

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 350
receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 351
Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 352
maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 353
connection. 354

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 355
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 356
Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 357
research projects. 358

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 359
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 360
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 361
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 362
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 363
state. 364

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 365
receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 366
Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 367
contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 368

baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 369

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 370
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 371
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 372
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 373
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 374
programs on a statewide basis. 375

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 376
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 377
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 378

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 379
receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 380
Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 381
Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 382
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 383
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 384
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 385
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 386
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 387
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 388
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 389
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 390
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 391
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 392
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 393
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 394
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 395
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 396
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 397
organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 398

subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 399
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 400
purpose. 401

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 402
receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the 403
Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school 404
district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 405
expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 406
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 407
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 408
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 409
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 410
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 411
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 412
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 413
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 414
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 415
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 416
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 417
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 418
district to receive training in providing such services to the 419
students of the school district. The school district shall 420
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 421
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 422
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 423
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 424
purpose. 425

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 426
receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the 427
Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school 428
district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 429

expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 430
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 431
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 432
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 433
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 434
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 435
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 436
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 437
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 438
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 439
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 440
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 441
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 442
district to receive training in providing such services to the 443
students of the school district. The school district shall 444
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 445
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 446
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 447
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 448
purpose. 449

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 450
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 451
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 452
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 453
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 454
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 455
financial need. 456

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 457
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 458
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 459
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 460

driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 461
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 462
vocational school districts. 463

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 464
receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the 465
friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money 466
to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free 467
emergency medical first response throughout Israel. 468

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 469
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 470
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 471
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 472
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 473
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 474
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 475
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 476

Sec. 4503.556. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 477
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 478
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 479
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 480
and issuance of "triple negative breast cancer awareness" 481
license plates. An application made under this section may be 482
combined with a request for a special reserved license plate 483
under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon 484
receipt of the completed application and compliance by the 485
applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the 486
registrar shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle 487
registration and a set of "triple negative breast cancer 488
awareness" license plates and a validation sticker, or a 489
validation sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of 490

the Revised Code. 491

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 492
inscribed on the license plates, "triple negative breast cancer 493
awareness" license plates shall be inscribed with identifying 494
words or markings that are designed by the Erica J. Holloman 495
foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple negative breast 496
cancer. The registrar shall approve the final design. "Triple 497
negative breast cancer awareness" license plates shall display 498
county identification stickers that identify the county of 499
registration as required under section 4503.19 of the Revised 500
Code. 501

(B) "Triple negative breast cancer awareness" license 502
plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone, 503
shall be issued upon receipt of a contribution as provided in 504
division (C)(1) of this section; upon payment of the regular 505
license tax as prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised 506
Code, any applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under 507
Chapter 4504. of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee 508
prescribed by section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, 509
and a bureau of motor vehicles administrative fee of ten 510
dollars; and upon compliance with all other applicable laws 511
relating to the registration of motor vehicles. 512

(C)(1) For each application for registration and 513
registration renewal notice the registrar receives under this 514
section, the registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty- 515
five dollars. The registrar shall transmit this contribution 516
into the state treasury to the credit of the license plate 517
contribution fund created in section 4501.21 of the Revised 518
Code. 519

(2) The registrar shall deposit the bureau administrative 520

fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the 521
bureau for additional services required in the issuing of 522
"triple negative breast cancer awareness" license plates, into 523
the state treasury to the credit of the state bureau of motor 524
vehicles fund created in section 4501.25 of the Revised Code. 525

Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 526
Code is hereby repealed. 527
