BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.514 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state	6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall	7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants	8

4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, and 4503.97 of the Revised 20 Code. 21 (B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 22 registrar collects in the fund as follows: 23 The registrar shall pay the contributions received 24 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 25 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 26 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 27 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 28 quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 29 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 30 other abortion-related activities. 31 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 32 receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 33

organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.

The registrar shall pay the contributions received40pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism41society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs42and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.43

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 44 receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 45 national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 46 amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 47 chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 48

chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to49assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services50directly to their clients.51

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 52 receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 53 national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 54 it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 55 pancreatic cancer and their families. 56

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social support services for adults who have sickle cell disease.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar62receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to63special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions64for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.65

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar66receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the67children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the68contributions for its research and other programs.69

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70 receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 71 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 72 contributions into its general account to be used for 73 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 74 America foundation. 75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar76receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the77

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 81 pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 82 cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 83 scholarships and other educational activities. 84

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 85 pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 86 organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 87 contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 88 that organization. 89

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the university or college whose name or marking or design appears on collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that section. A university or college that receives contributions from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general scholarship fund.

97 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 98 university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 99 awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 100 the university. The university shall not use more than twenty 101 per cent of the funds it receives for purposes of administering 102 the scholarship program. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 114 receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 115 fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 116 the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 117 lighthouses of fairport harbor. 118

Each power squadron district shall use the money it receives under this section to pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or sponsors within this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 131 receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 132 Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 133 international, which shall use the money it receives under this 134 section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 135 activities. 136

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 210 receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 211 western reserve historical society, which shall use the 212 contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 213

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 214 receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 215 state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 216 deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 217 establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 218 distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 219 ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 220 for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 221 222 managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 223 registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 224 such payments are to be made. 225

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar231receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to232Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute233to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve.234

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use the money in support of the park.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 239 receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 240 Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 241 contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 242 information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 243 local beekeeping programs. 244

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 245 receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 246 national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 247 contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 248 legends to inspire future leaders. 249

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created250pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each251contribution the registrar receives under that section that an252applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a253professional sports team located in the county of that sports254commission and that is participating in the license plate255

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar264receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to265monarch wings across Ohio, which shall use the contributions for266the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and267pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs.268

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar269receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the270Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 274 receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 275 great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 276 America. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar285receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the286Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio,287which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.288

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar289receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the290fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall291deposit the fees into its general account to be used for292purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated.293

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 294 receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 295 fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 296 deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 297 used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 298 enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 299 methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 300

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar327receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to328Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the329contributions into its general account to be used for purposes330of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.331

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 332 receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 333 Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 334 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 335 Cleveland, Ohio. 336

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 337 receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 338 Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 339 moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 340 4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 341 agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 342

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 349 receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 350 Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 351 352 contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 353

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 354 receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 355 Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 356 maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 357 connection. 358

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area research projects.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 363 receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 364 Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 365 contributions solely to promote and support the historical 366 preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 369 receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 370 Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 371

contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth372baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City.373

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 374 receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 375 American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 376 chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 377 contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 378 programs on a statewide basis. 379

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the nationwide children's hospital foundation.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 383 receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 384 Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 385 Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 386 contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 387 students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 388 pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 389 students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 390 emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 391 include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 392 techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 393 education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 394 abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 395 providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 396 faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 397 services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 398 discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 399 charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 400 services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 401

organization is exempt from federal income taxation under402subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school403shall not use the contributions it receives for any other404purpose.405

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 406 receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the 407 Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school 408 district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 409 expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 410 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 411 412 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 413 defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 414 counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 415 violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 416 The school district superintendent or, in the school district 417 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 418 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 419 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 420 services. The school district also may use the contributions it 421 receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 422 district to receive training in providing such services to the 423 students of the school district. The school district shall 424 ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 425 district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 426 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 427 shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 428 purpose. 429

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar430receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the431Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school432

district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 433 expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 434 district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 435 mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 436 provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 437 defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 438 counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 439 violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 440 The school district superintendent or, in the school district 441 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 442 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 443 organizations that the school district hires to provide those 444 services. The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar461receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the462Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money463

solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated464driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by465boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint466vocational school districts.467

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free emergency medical first response throughout Israel.

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 473 contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 474 the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 475 distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 476 section the investment income the fund earned the previous 477 calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 478 entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 479 received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 480

Sec. 4503.514. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 481 car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, 482 motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, 483 or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor 484 vehicles, and, effective January 1, 2017, the owner or lessee of 485 any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter may apply to the 486 registrar for the registration of the vehicle and issuance of 487 "University of Notre Dame" license plates.
