- (F) The department of public safety shall enforce 74 75 compliance with orders and rules of the public utilities commission and applicable laws in accordance with Chapters 76 4905., 4921., and 4923. of the Revised Code regarding commercial 77 motor vehicle transportation safety, economic, and hazardous 78 materials requirements. 79 (G) Notwithstanding Chapter 4117. of the Revised Code, the 80 department of public safety may establish requirements for its 81 enforcement personnel, including its enforcement agents 82 described in section 5502.14 of the Revised Code, that include 83 standards of conduct, work rules and procedures, and criteria 84 for eligibility as law enforcement personnel. 85 (H) The department shall administer, maintain, and operate 86 the Ohio criminal justice network.
