BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4113.13 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 4113.13. No employer shall include on any form for	8
application for employment with the employer any question	9
concerning whether the applicant has been convicted of or	10
pleaded guilty to a felony in this state or any other	11
jurisdiction.	12
Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an	13
employer from completing a criminal records check as part of any	14
application process if otherwise permitted by law.	15
As used in this section, "employer" has the same meaning	16
as in section 4113.51 of the Revised Code.	17
