A C O N C U R R E N T R E S O L U T I O N

To commend Governor John Kasich, Ohio's agricultural 1
community, and Ohio's environmental advocacy and research 2
organizations on their efforts to improve the water quality 3
of Lake Erie and to affirm the Governor's ability to form 4
an interstate compact with other states in furtherance of 5
this objective. 6

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, Governor John Kasich, Ohio's agricultural community, 7
and Ohio's environmental advocacy and research organizations have 8
consistently supported bipartisan efforts to improve the water 9
quality of Lake Erie; and 10

WHEREAS, The Governor supported bipartisan legislation to 11
prohibit the spread of manure on frozen and rain-soaked ground in 12
the Western Lake Erie Basin unless injection, tillage, or cover 13
crops are used and to eliminate all open-lake dredging and disposal 14
by 2020; and 15

WHEREAS, The Governor, Ohio's agricultural community, and 16
Ohio's environmental advocacy and research organizations have made 17
improving water quality in Lake Erie a priority in the state; and 18

WHEREAS, The Governor should continue to engage in a dialogue 19
with officials in other states in furtherance of this objective, 20
including pursuing the formation of an interstate compact; now 21
therefore be it 22

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 131st General Assembly 23
of the State of Ohio, commend Governor John Kasich, Ohio's 24
agricultural community, and Ohio's environmental advocacy and 25
research organizations for their efforts to improve the water 26
quality of Lake Erie and encourage the Governor to continue to 27
communicate with other states in furtherance of that objective, 28
including pursuing the formation of an interstate compact; and be 29
it further 30
