Recognizing Women's History Month in Ohio, March 2015.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 131st General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize March 2015 as Women's History Month in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, In California in 1978, the Education Task Force of the Sonoma County Commission on the Status of Women initiated a Women's History Week celebration, focused around March 8 as International Women's Day, to raise awareness of the role of women in history. By 1981, the United States Congress officially declared the week of March 8 as National Women's History Week and, in 1987, designated March as National Women's History Month; and

WHEREAS, American women of every race, class, religious affiliation, and ethnic background have made historic contributions to the growth and strength of our nation in countless ways. They have been leaders of the fabric of our society and contributed to social change, not only in securing their own rights of suffrage and equal opportunity but also in the abolitionist, emancipation, industrial, labor, civil
