A R E S O L U T I O N

Honoring Glenn Zimmerman as a 2015 Pistol
Intercollegiate National Champion.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to congratulate Glenn Zimmerman on winning the 2015 Pistol Intercollegiate National Championships in the men's 3-gun aggregate category; and

WHEREAS, A student at The Ohio State University, Glenn Zimmerman has combined talent and competitive spirit with the highest ideals of good sportsmanship to establish himself as a truly exceptional young competitor. With admirable dedication, he has worked diligently toward attaining ultimate proficiency in pistol shooting, and as a result, he won second place in the standard pistol category with 554 points, fourth place in the free pistol category with 523 points, and eighth place in the air category with 557 points to accumulate 1634 points to place first in the men's 3-gun aggregate category. He was named to the All-American first team in the free and standard pistol categories and second team in the air pistol category, and he helped the Buckeyes secure their second consecutive open team title at this year's Pistol Intercollegiate National Championships; and

WHEREAS, Glenn Zimmerman's accomplishments and leadership, both in and out of competition, are a justifiable source of pride and a fine reflection not only on him but also on his family, his teammates, his coaches, his university, and his hometown.
