BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4755.40 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4755.40. As used in sections 4755.40 to 4755.56 and	6
4755.99 of the Revised Code:	7
(A) "Physical therapy" means the evaluation and treatment	8
of a person by physical measures and the use of therapeutic	9
exercises and rehabilitative procedures, with or without	10
assistive devices, for the purpose of preventing, correcting, or	11
alleviating any disability physical impairments, functional	12
limitations, and physical disabilities. If	13
All of the following apply to "physical therapy":	14
(1) "Physical therapy" includes the establishment and	15
modification of physical therapy programs, treatment planning,	16
patient education and instruction, and consultative services.	17

(2) In the evaluation of a person, "physical therapy"	18	
includes determining a physical therapy diagnosis in order to	19	
treat the person's physical impairments, functional limitations,	20	
and physical disabilities; determining a prognosis; and	21	
determining a plan of therapeutic intervention.	22	
(3) If performed by a person who is adequately trained,	23	
<pre>physical therapy includes all of the following:</pre>	24	
(1) The the design, fabrication, and revision of various	25	
assistive devices, and the provision of education, and	26	
instruction in the use of various assistive those devices .	27	
including braces, splints, ambulatory or locomotion devices,	28

(2) The (4) "Physical therapy" includes the administration	30	
of topical drugs that have been prescribed by a licensed health		
professional authorized to prescribe drugs, as defined in
