**A BILL**

To enact sections 5534.802 and 5534.803 of the 1  
Revised Code to designate a portion of State 2  
Route 61 in Erie County as the "SGT David Sexton 3  
Memorial Highway" and a portion of Benton- 4  
Carroll Road in Ottawa County as "SGT Glen 5  
Millinger Memorial Highway." 6

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That sections 5534.802 and 5534.803 of the 7  
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 8

**Sec. 5534.802.** The northbound and southbound lanes of 9  
state route number sixty-one between the intersection of that 10  
route and state route number one hundred thirteen and the 11  
intersection of state route number sixty-one and Mason road, in 12  
Erie county, shall be known as the "SGT David Sexton Memorial 13  
Highway." 14

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 15  
along the highway indicating its name. 16

**Sec. 5534.803.** The northbound and southbound lanes of 17

Benton-Carroll road between the intersection of that road and 18  
state route number one hundred sixty-three and the intersection 19  
of Benton-Carroll road and West Bier road, in Ottawa county, 20  
shall be known as the "SGT Glen Millinger Memorial Highway." 21

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 22  
along the highway indicating its name. 23
