#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4301.612 of the Revised Code be	8
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 4301.612. (A) Any court that sentences an offender	10
for an offense of violence, as defined in section 2901.01 of the	11
Revised Code, that occurred on a premises for which an A-1-A, A-	12
1c, or D liquor permit is issued shall submit a report of the	13
offense to the attorney general. The report shall contain all of	14
the following:	15
(1) The name of the offender;	16
(2) The address of the offender;	17

(3) The driver's license number or identification card	18	
number of the offender, if applicable;

(4) The offense for which the offender was sentenced, the	20 21	
date of the commission of that offense, and a short description		
of the offense.	22	
(B) The attorney general shall establish and maintain a	23	
database that contains the information submitted under division	24	
(A) of this section. The attorney general shall provide access	25	
to the database only to persons who hold an A-1-A, A-1c, or D	26	
liquor permit.		
The attorney general shall remove information submitted	28	
under division (A) of this section from the database three years	29	
after the date on which the attorney general receives the		
information.		
(C)(1) The holder of an A-1-A, A-1c, or D liquor permit,	32	
or an agent of the holder of such a permit, may use the	33	
inclusion of a person in the database established under division	34	
(B) of this section as the basis for refusing admission into or		
onto the permit premises.	36	
(2) Except for the purposes of division (C)(1) of this	37	
section, no person shall publicly disclose any information	38	
contained in the database established under division (B) of this
