**A BILL**

To enact section 5.49 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate September 15 to October 15 each year 2  
as "Hispanic and Latino Heritage Month." 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5.49 of the Revised Code be 4  
enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 5.49.** To designate the fifteenth day of September to 6  
the fifteenth day of October each year as "Hispanic and Latino 7  
Heritage Month" to honor and recognize the contributions that 8  
Hispanic and Latino Americans have made to this state and to the 9  
United States. 10
