A BILL

To enact section 9.64 of the Revised Code to cease
payments to a subdivision that materially
hinders or prevents its personnel from carrying
and using naloxone.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 9.64 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 9.64. (A) As used in this section, "subdivision"
means a municipal corporation, township, or county.

(B) No subdivision shall enact or maintain an ordinance,
policy, directive, rule, or resolution that would materially
hinder or prevent an officer or employee of that subdivision
from doing either of the following:

(1) Obtaining, maintaining, or accessing naloxone;

(2) Administering naloxone to an individual who is
apparently experiencing an opioid-related overdose.

(C) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no funds in
the possession or custody of the state shall be disbursed to a
subdivision that is in violation of division (B) of this
