A BILL

To enact section 3901.80 of the Revised Code to
prohibit insurers from discriminating against
living organ donors.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3901.80 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

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Sec. 3901.80. (A) As used in this section:

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(1) "Living organ donor" means a living person who donates
an organ to another living person.

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(2) "Policy of insurance" means a life insurance policy,
disability insurance policy, or long-term care insurance policy.

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(B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
an insurer shall not discriminate against a living organ donor
in the offering, issuance, price, or conditions of a policy of
insurance based solely, and without any additional actuarial
risks, on that person's status as a living organ donor.

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(C) A violation of division (B) of this section shall be
considered an unfair and deceptive practice in the business of

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insurance under section 3901.21 of the Revised Code. 18

(D) The superintendent of insurance may adopt rules as 19
necessary to carry out the requirements of this section. 20
