(B) Appointments to the Study Committee shall be made not	27
later than thirty days after the effective date of this section.	28
Members of the Study Committee shall serve without compensation	29
or reimbursement.	30
(C) The chairperson of the committee primarily responsible	31
for transportation issues in the House of Representatives shall	32
serve as the chairperson of the Study Committee. The Department	33
of Transportation shall provide the Study Committee with any	34
administrative assistance as determined necessary by the Study	35

(D) The Study Committee shall do all of the following:	37
(1) Examine local and state government efforts regarding	38
the construction of infrastructure to support electric vehicles;	39
(2) Estimate the costs of constructing and maintaining a	40
statewide infrastructure that supports electric vehicles;	41
(3) Identify funding sources to support the construction	42

(4) Develop recommendations for changes to state and local	44

(E) The Study Committee shall complete a report with its	50
findings and recommendations not later than May 31, 2019. The	51
Study Committee shall submit the report to the Governor, the	52
Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President of	53
the Senate. The Study Committee also shall make the report	54
available to the public.	55
(F) Upon submission of its report, the Study Committee	56
shall cease to exist.	57
(G) As used in this section, "electric vehicle" means a	58
vehicle that exclusively uses one or more electric motors for	59
propulsion.	60
