To amend sections 3501.35 and 3599.20 of the

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Revised Code to allow an elector to photograph and make public the elector's own marked ballot.

Section 1. That sections 3501.35 and 3599.20 of the	4
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3501.35. (A) During an election and the counting of	6
the ballots, no person shall do any of the following:	7
(1) Loiter, congregate, or engage in any kind of election	8
campaigning within the area between the polling place and the	9
small flags of the United States placed on the thoroughfares and	10
walkways leading to the polling place, and if the line of	11
electors waiting to vote extends beyond those small flags,	12
within ten feet of any elector in that line;	13
(2) In any manner hinder or delay an elector in reaching	14
or leaving the place fixed for casting the elector's ballot;	15
(3) Give, tender, or exhibit any ballot or ticket to any	16
person other than the elector's own ballot to the precinct	17
election officials within the area between the nolling place and	1.8

(2) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the	35
contrary, a journalist shall be allowed reasonable access to a	36
polling place during an election. As used in this division,	37
"journalist" has the same meaning as in division (B)(2) of	38
section 2923.129 of the Revised Code.	39
(C) No more electors shall be allowed to approach the	40
voting shelves at any time than there are voting shelves	41
provided.	42
(D) The precinct election officials and the police officer	43
shall strictly enforce the observance of this section.	44

Section 2. That existing sections 3501.35 and 3599.20 of	75
the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	76
Section 3. Section 3501.35 of the Revised Code is	77
presented in this act as a composite of the section as amended	78
by both Am. S.B. 10 and Am. Sub. S.B. 109 of the 130th General	79
Assembly. The General Assembly, applying the principle stated in	80
division (B) of section 1.52 of the Revised Code that amendments	81
are to be harmonized if reasonably capable of simultaneous	82
operation, finds that the composite is the resulting version of	83
the section in effect prior to the effective date of the section	84
as presented in this act	8.5
