**A BILL**

To enact section 5.281 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate the first week of May as In-Demand 2  
Jobs Week. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5.281 of the Revised Code be 4  
enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 5.281.** Beginning in 2018, and every year thereafter, 6  
the full week beginning on the first Monday in May is designated 7  
as in-demand jobs week. 8

Every year during in-demand jobs week, the governor's 9  
office of workforce transformation, in collaboration with the 10  
departments of job and family services, education, and higher 11

education, shall organize activities to raise awareness among 12  
educators, students, and parents of jobs that are in demand by 13  
employers operating in this state and the requirements and 14  
benefits of those jobs. The activities shall include job fairs 15  
and company tours to connect middle and high school students 16  
with employers. 17
