## A RESOLUTION

Honoring the Village of Zoar on its Bicentennial.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 132nd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize the Village of Zoar on the jubilant occasion of its Bicentennial; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Zoar was founded in 1817 by German immigrants who sought to establish a new community where they could practice their faith freely, and this fine communal settlement flourished from 1819 to 1898, when the group disbanded. The legacy of their labors endures today thanks to the vigilance, industriousness, and generosity of the village's remaining population who have devoted themselves to preserving the unique history of the area; and

WHEREAS, This is, indeed, an auspicious milestone for the Village of Zoar, and celebration is certainly in order, for the residents of this National Historic Landmark have never relinquished their appreciation for the worthiest virtues of the past. Without sacrificing their sense of tradition in the name of progress, the people of Zoar have managed to nurture a fresh perspective and a positive outlook that endear this distinctive place to all who know it well; and
