## **A RESOLUTION**

Recognizing National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month, January 2018.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the	1
132nd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize January	2
2018 as National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month;	3
and	4
WHEREAS, Slavery and human trafficking include the use and	5
transportation of persons through coercion, deception, or use or	6
threat of force or violence and for such forms of exploitation as	7
forced labor and sexual servitude. The United Nations	8
International Labour Organization estimates that 40 million men,	9
women, and children worldwide are currently being exploited in	10
this way, and the U.S. Department of State estimates that between	11
600,000 and 800,000 of them, mostly women and girls, are	12
trafficked annually across international borders, including 14,500	13
to 17,500 into the United States. Additionally, it is estimated	14
that 1,000 minors in Ohio are currently being forced to sell sex,	15
with more than 2,000 others potentially at risk of being	16
trafficked, and statistics show that the average age of those	17
entering the commercial sex market is between twelve and fourteen	18
years old; and	19
WHEREAS, In the United States, President Abraham Lincoln	20
signed the Emancipation Proclamation on January 1, 1863, and the	21
13th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution on February 1, 1865,	22
effectively ending slavery in our country. In commemoration of	23

these historic events, President Donald Trump has proclaimed

Declaration of Human Rights on December 10, 1948, to denounce such	27
atrocities on a global scale; and	28

injustice, urge other nations to pass and enforce slavery and	31
human trafficking laws, and assist and support those who are	32
