A RESOLUTION

Honoring the Columbus Africentric Early College girls
basketball team on winning the 2018 Division III State
Championship.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 1
132nd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to pay tribute to the 2
Columbus Africentric Early College girls basketball team as the 3
2018 Division III State Champion; and 4

WHEREAS, The talented Columbus Africentric Early College 5
girls basketball team is to be heartily commended for defeating a 6
tough Versailles squad and decisively securing this year's 7
Division III State Championship. The 53-47 victory of the Nubians, 8
which capped a fantastic 27-3 season, reflects an outstanding 9
collective effort by a gifted group of athletes. Without 10
exception, they had prepared conscientiously in pursuit of the 11
