A RESOLUTION

Recognizing Veterans Day, November 11, 2018.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the

132nd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize November 2 11, 2018, as Veterans Day and the One Hundredth Anniversary of the 3 end of World War I; and 4 WHEREAS, Armistice Day was established when representatives 5 of the Allies and Germany signed a peace agreement to formally end 6 World War I at Compiègne, France, on November 11, 1918. That date 7 became a national holiday in the United States in 1938, and in 8 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower officially changed the name 9 of the holiday to Veterans Day. During World War I, approximately 10 263,000 Ohioans served our nation in the 42nd Rainbow and 37th 11 Buckeye divisions and the 369th and 372nd infantry regiments, and 12 6,500 made the ultimate sacrifice. The members of the Ohio House 13 of Representatives honor the memory of those brave Ohioans who 14 fought in World War I, for they were a key to the Allied victory; 15 and 16 WHEREAS, Since its establishment a century ago, Veterans Day 17 has become a time to honor not only those who participated in 18 World War I but all those who have served in the U.S. armed 19 forces, in both war and peacetime. On this solemn occasion, the 20 citizens of Ohio have the opportunity to reflect on the sacrifices 21 of the past and to express their profound gratitude to all 22 veterans; and 23 WHEREAS, It is imperative that we openly acknowledge our 24

debt to those who bore our country's standard with courage,
