A RESOLUTION

Honoring Kyle Snyder as the 2018 NCAA heavyweight
wrestling champion.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 132nd General 1
Assembly of Ohio are pleased to commend Kyle Snyder on winning the 2
2018 National Collegiate Athletic Association heavyweight 3
championship in wrestling; and 4

WHEREAS, Displaying exceptional form, ability, leadership, 5
and dedication during the 2017-2018 season, Kyle Snyder has 6
certainly distinguished himself as one of the most talented 7
wrestlers in the country. A valued senior member of The Ohio State 8
University wrestling team, he avenged his only collegiate loss by 9
triumphantly beating Adam Coon of Michigan twice, a first win to 10
claim the Big Ten heavyweight title for the third consecutive 11
year, and a subsequent win to claim his third NCAA crown with a 3- 12
2 victory; and 13

WHEREAS, Throughout intense training and preparation, Kyle 14
Snyder has consistently demonstrated the talent, integrity, and 15
motivation that are the hallmarks of a true champion. He has 16
inspired his teammates, thrilled his fans, gained the respect of 17
