BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4511.84 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4511.84. (A) No person shall operate a motor vehicle-	7
while wearing earphones over, or earplugs in, both ears. As used	8
in this section, "earphones" :	9
(1) "Earphones" means any headset, radio, tape player, or	10

other similar device that <u>covers all or a portion of both ears</u>	11

(a) Through either a physical connection to another device 13 or a wireless connection, provides the listener with radio 14 programs, music, or other recorded information through a device 15 attached to the head and that covers all or a portion of both-16 17 ears; (b) Provides hearing protection. "Earphones" 18 "Earphones" does not include speakers or other listening 19 devices that are built into protective headgear. 20 (2) "Earplugs" means any device that can be inserted into 21 one or both ears and that does either of the following: 22 (a) Through either a physical connection to another device 23 or a wireless connection, provides the listener with radio 24 programs, music, or other information; 25 26 (b) Provides hearing protection. (B) No person shall operate a motor vehicle while wearing 27 earphones over, or earplugs in, both ears. 28 29 (C) This section does not apply to: (1) Any person wearing a hearing aid; 30 (2) Law enforcement personnel while on duty; 31 (3) Fire department personnel and emergency medical 32 33 service personnel while on duty; (4) Any person engaged in the operation of equipment for 34 use in the maintenance or repair of any highway; 35

(C) (D) Except as otherwise provided in this division, 40 whoever violates this section is quilty of a minor misdemeanor. 41 If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has 42 been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one predicate motor 43 vehicle or traffic offense, whoever violates this section is 44 guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. If, within one 45 year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted 46 of two or more predicate motor vehicle or traffic offenses, 47 whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the 48 third degree. 49

Section 2. That existing section 4511.84 of the Revised50Code is hereby repealed.51
