A BILL

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. All items in this section are hereby 4
appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 5
treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 6
appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 7
for fiscal year 2020 and those in the second column are for 8
fiscal year 2021. The appropriations made in this act are in 9
addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 10
2021 biennium. 11

Section 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures
from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for
as though made in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. 18

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all
provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are
generally applicable to such appropriations. 25

Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to
address urgent needs of the state arising from a COVID-19
outbreak. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect. 28
