To amend section 3599.13 of the Revised Code to	1
prohibit a person from taking certain actions to	2
prevent the circulation of an election petition.	3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3599.13 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3599.13. (A) No person shall do any of the following:	6
(1) Sign an initiative, supplementary, referendum, recall,	7
or nominating petition knowing that the person is not at the	8
time qualified to sign it;	9
(2) Knowingly sign such a petition more than once;	10
(3) Except as otherwise provided in section 3501.382 of	11
the Revised Code, sign a name other than the person's own on	12
such a petition;	13
(4) Accept anything of value for signing such a petition;	14
(5) Seek by intimidation or threats to influence any	15

person to sign or refrain from signing <u>to circulate</u> such a	16
petition , or from circulating or abstaining from circulating	17
such a petition;	18

(6) Sign a declaration of candidacy and petition for a	19
candidate of a party with which the person is not affiliated, as	20
required by section 3513.05 of the Revised Code;	21
(7) Make a false affidavit or statement concerning the	22
signatures on any such petition.	23
(B) Whoever (1) No person shall knowingly do any of the	24
following with respect to an initiative, supplementary,	25
referendum, recall, or nominating petition or any other petition	26
to be filed with the secretary of state, a board of elections,	27
or another public office for the purpose of becoming a candidate	28
for any elective office, including the office of a political	29
party, for the purpose of submitting a question or issue to the	30
electors at an election, or for the purpose of forming a	31
political party:	32
(a) Seek by interference, threat, intimidation, or	33
compensation to influence any person to refrain from signing	34
such a petition or to refrain from circulating such a petition;	35
(b) Companyate any person in evehance for the person	36
(b) Compensate any person in exchange for the person	
acting in violation of division (B)(1)(a) of this section;	37
(c) Authorize or direct an employee, as part of the	38
employee's job duties, to act in violation of division (B)(1)(a)	39
of this section;	40
(d) Compensate any person in exchange for the person	41
agreeing to refrain from causing another person to circulate	42
such a petition.	43

(2) For purposes of division (B)(1) of this section,	44
compensation includes any loan, gift, deposit, forgiveness of	45
indebtedness, donation, advance, payment, or transfer of funds	46
or anything of value, and the payment by any person other than	47
the person to whom the services are rendered for the personal	48
services of another person.	49
(C)(1) Whoever violates division (A) of this section shall	50
be fined not less than fifty or more than five hundred dollars,	51
or imprisoned not less than three or more than six months, or	52
both.	53
(2) Whoever violates division (B) of this section is	54
guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.	55
Section 2. That existing section 3599.13 of the Revised	56
Code is hereby repealed.	57
