Section 1. (A) As used in this section, "benefits" has the	4
same meaning as in section 4141.01 of the Revised Code.	5
(B) Notwithstanding division (B)(1) of section 4141.35 of	6
the Revised Code, during the period of the emergency declared by	7
Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, the Director	8
of Job and Family Services shall not take any action to recover	9
benefits to which an individual was not entitled unless either	10
of the following apply:	11
(1) The benefits were paid to the individual because the	12
individual engaged in fraudulent misrepresentation with the	13
object of obtaining benefits to which the individual was not	14
entitled;	15
(2) The individual received an overpayment from an	16
unemployment benefit program of the United States or another	17
state and the overpayment has not previously been recovered.	18

(C) The Director shall recover benefits obtained through	19
fraudulent misrepresentation in accordance with division (A) of	20
section 4141.35 of the Revised Code.	21
The Director shall recover an overpayment described in	22
division (B)(2) of this section in accordance with division (B)	23
(2) of section 4141.35 of the Revised Code.	24
(D) The time period described in division (B)(1) of	25
section 4141.35 of the Revised Code for collecting a benefit	26
that the Director is prohibited from collecting under this	27
section is tolled during the period of the emergency declared by	28
Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020.	29
Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	30
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	31
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	32
minimize the impact to Ohio workers from the COVID-19 outbreak.	33
Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.	34
