A BILL

To exempt specified liquor permit holders from the	1
requirement to renew their permits in calendar	2
year 2021 and to declare an emergency.	3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) Notwithstanding any section of the Revised 4 Code or any other law to the contrary, a person that holds a 5 valid A-1-A or class D permit issued under Chapter 4303. of the 6 Revised Code on the effective date of this section shall renew 7 the person's permit as follows: 8 (1) If the person is scheduled to renew the permit by 9 February 1, 2021, the person instead shall renew the permit not 10 later than February 1, 2022. 11 (2) If the person is scheduled to renew the permit by June 12 1, 2021, the person instead shall renew the permit not later 13 than June 1, 2022. 14 (3) If the person is scheduled to renew the permit by 15 October 1, 2021, the person instead shall renew the permit not 16 later than October 1, 2022. 17 (B) Permits remain valid until the applicable renewal date 18

set forth in this section, unless suspended or revoked.	19
(C) The Division of Liquor Control shall adopt rules in	20
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code necessary to	21
administer and enforce this section.	22
Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	23
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	24
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	25
provide economic relief to liquor permit holders as a result of	26
the COVID-19 outbreak. Therefore, this act shall go into	27
immediate effect.	28
