A BILL

To enact section 5.078 of the Revised Code to
designate the *Dunkleosteus terrelli* as the
official state fossil fish.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.078 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.078. *Dunkleosteus terrelli*, a species of extinct
arthrodire placoderm fish that lived in the seas that covered
parts of Ohio during the Late Devonian period, about three
hundred fifty-nine to three hundred eighty-two million years
ago, is hereby adopted as the official fossil fish of the state.
