A BILL

To amend section 3781.1010 of the Revised Code to
extend until November 30, 2022, the moratorium
on the building code requirement for storm
shelters for school construction projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3781.1010 of the Revised Code be
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3781.1010. (A) No rule of the board of building
standards for the erection, construction, repair, alteration,
and maintenance of buildings adopted under section 3781.10 of
the Revised Code shall require the installation of a storm
shelter in any school building operated by a public or private
school prior to ~~September 15, 2020, November 30, 2022,~~ or in any
such school building undergoing or about to undergo
construction, alteration, repair, or maintenance for which
financing has been secured prior to that date.

(B) Any rule adopted by the board that conflicts with this
section shall not be effective with respect to any school

building prior to ~~September 15, 2020~~November 30, 2022. 18

(C) As used in this section, "school building," "public 19
school," and "private school" have the same meanings as in 20
section 3781.106 of the Revised Code. 21

Section 2. That existing section 3781.1010 of the Revised 22
Code is hereby repealed. 23
