### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 777** - Representatives Lang, Perales.

Cosponsors: Representatives Cutrona, Cross, Reineke, Scherer, Zeltwanger, Riedel, Richardson, Kick, Jones, Carfagna, Stoltzfus, Carruthers, Holmes, A., Hambley, Wiggam, Romanchuk, Becker.

To reinstate the authorized hours of operation for liquor permit premises that existed prior to the state of emergency declared in response to COVID-19 and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 778** - Representatives Rogers, Patterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lightbody, O'Brien, Sheehy, Sobocki, Patton.

To amend section 2919.27 of the Revised Code to allow a court to order electronic monitoring of a person who violates a protection order.

**H. B. No. 779** - Representatives Clites, Miranda.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boyd, Carfagna, Crossman, Galonski, Lepore-Hagan, Lightbody, Lipps, Liston, Sweeney, West.

To amend sections 3959.01, 3959.04, 3959.05, 3959.11, 3959.12, 3959.15, 3959.16, and 3959.20 and to enact section 3959.21 of the Revised Code regarding pharmacy benefit managers.

**H. B. No. 780** - Representatives Romanchuk, Jones.

Cosponsors: Representatives Edwards, Becker, Butler, Kelly, Carfagna, Patton, Reineke, Ingram, Riedel, Smith, K., Seitz.

To enact section 5534.512 of the Revised Code to designate a bridge along State Route 7 in Marietta as the "Andy Thompson Memorial Bridge."

**H. B. No. 781** - Representative Patton.

To amend section 4513.21 of the Revised Code to require certain trucks to be equipped with an audible alarm that sounds upon raising the truck bed, and to name the act the "Daniel Ripepi Act."

Said bills were considered the first time.
