**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Recognition of this prestigious milestone is a 5  
fitting tribute to Hamilton County Public Health, for throughout 6

Passed into law by the Ohio Legislature in 1919, the Hughes- 8  
Griswold Act set the guidelines for the creation of public health 9
