A RESOLUTION

Recognizing Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Ohio,
October 2019.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 133rd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize October 2019 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Through the systematic use of physical, emotional, sexual, psychological, and economic control or abuse, the crime of domestic violence violates an individual's privacy, dignity, security, and humanity, and children who grow up in violent homes are believed to be abused and neglected at a rate higher than the national average. It has negatively impacted countless lives, and it is our responsibility to help break this cycle of violence; and

WHEREAS, Domestic violence affects people of all races, ages, income levels, and sexes, and only a coordinated community effort will put a stop to this terrible crime. Domestic Violence Awareness Month is an appropriate time to lend support to those whose lives have been devastated by this heinous crime; and
