A RESOLUTION

Honoring Dublin City Schools on the Centennial of its 1919 Building.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 133rd General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to pay tribute to Dublin City Schools on the auspicious occasion of the One Hundredth Anniversary of its 1919 Building, commemorated June 8, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Due to an overwhelming need for a building that would accommodate the growing population and number of children attending kindergarten through twelfth grade, Dublin City Schools opened the 25,500-square-foot, three-story 1919 Building in September of 1919. Originally, the edifice housed every grade level, and when it fell into disrepair in the 1980s, renovations commenced after city officials dismissed the consideration to raze an important and structurally sound historical landmark in the community; and

WHEREAS, Dublin City Schools' oldest-standing structure, the 1919 Building has served as a place to not only receive an education but also to make memories. The important edifice is now a part of the John Sells Middle School complex, and the celebration of its Centennial will allow staff, students, and alumni the opportunity to pay tribute to the storied history of this significant institution; and

WHEREAS, The Dublin City Schools' 1919 Building stands as a testament to how citizens can come together to venerate the past and share a vision of progress and unity for the future. Indeed, this handsome brick building in the heart of Historic Dublin will stand as an example of the rich heritage of bygone days and the hope that comes with a city that continues to flourish; therefore
