A RESOLUTION

Recognizing October 2019 as Domestic Violence Awareness
Month in Ohio.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 133rd General 1
Assembly of Ohio take this opportunity to recognize October 2019 2
as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Ohio; and 3

WHEREAS, The month of October has been designated as Domestic 4
Violence Awareness Month in an effort to mourn those who have died 5
as a result of domestic violence, celebrate those who have 6
survived, and connect those who work for a better tomorrow. 7
Affecting men, women, and children of all races and socio-economic 8
backgrounds, domestic violence has long-lasting repercussions on 9
the victims, their families, and our communities as a whole, and 10
this month increases public awareness and understanding of the 11
issues surrounding domestic violence and abuse; and 12

WHEREAS, Domestic violence leads to a loss of dignity, and 13
the pain victims face as a result of their offenders' violations 14
against them is reflected throughout society. In order to prevent 15
the escalation of abuse in the future, it is vital for all 16
concerned citizens to develop a general consciousness regarding 17

potential victims and offenders about the avoidance of this 19
