A RESOLUTION

In memory of Ronald Eugene Rosser.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 133rd General 1
Assembly of Ohio extend heartfelt condolences to the family and 2
friends of Ronald Eugene Rosser in their time of bereavement; and 3

WHEREAS, Ron Rosser's zealous love of life and his selfless 4
concern for the welfare of others distinguished him as an 5
outstanding human being and as a leading citizen. A U.S. Army 6
veteran of both World War II and the Korean War, he was awarded 7
the Congressional Medal of Honor for the valor he displayed when 8
he stepped up for his injured captain and led his fellow troops in 9
a charge against enemy forces, and following his tour in Korea, he 10
continued to serve for twenty-two years before retiring at the 11
rank of Sergeant First Class. He was a dedicated and devoted 12
individual whose exemplary and decorated Army career serves as an 13
inspiration for others; and 14

WHEREAS, A man of exceptional concern and insight, Ron Rosser 15
also achieved a praiseworthy record of service as a lifelong 16
member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3297 and American Legion 17
Post 222. His untiring efforts extended to others through his 18
establishment of the Ron Rosser Public Service and the Richard and 19
Gary Rosser scholarships, which he named after his deceased 20
brothers so their memories would endure in his community; and 21

WHEREAS, Ron Rosser's personal sacrifices of time and energy 22
to his family, his friends, his community, and the State of Ohio 23
will certainly live beyond him, and he will long be remembered for 24
his kindness and his unwavering commitment to service. Though the 25
void that his death has created can never be filled, the warmth 26
and understanding that Ron Rosser so readily extended to his loved 27

ones, including his wife, the late Sandra Kay, his daughter, 28
Pamela, his two granddaughters, Amy and Melody, and his two great- 29
grandchildren, Bailey and Ryder, will stand as a testament to his 30
personal character, and he will be remembered fondly by all those 31
who knew and loved him; therefore be it 32
