Section 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, 24 the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 25 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 26 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 27 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 28 from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this 29 act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made 30 in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 31 appropriations made in these sections are subject to all 32 provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are 33 generally applicable to such appropriations. 34

Section 812.20.Sections 201.10, 209.10, and 250.10 of35this act are exempt from the referendum under Ohio Constitution,36Article II, section 1d and therefore take effect immediately37when this act becomes law.38

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
