BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 201.10. All items in the sections of this act 4 numbered in the 200s are hereby appropriated as designated out 5 of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the 6 7 designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in these sections, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2020 and 8 9 those in the second column are for fiscal year 2021. The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any 10 other operating appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 2021 11 biennium. 12

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the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 49 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 50 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 51 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 52 from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this 53 act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made 54 in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 55 appropriations made in these sections are subject to all 56 provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are 57 generally applicable to such appropriations. 58

Section 503.10. CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND REAPPROPRIATIONS

The Director of Budget and Management shall determine the amount of the unexpended, unencumbered portion of each appropriation item appropriated from the Coronavirus Relief Fund (Fund 5CV1) at the end of fiscal year 2021 to be reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2022. The amounts determined by the Director are hereby reappropriated.

Section 812.20.Sections 201.10, 205.10, 209.10, 215.10,66221.10, 250.10, and 503.10 of this act are exempt from the67referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, section 1d and68therefore take effect immediately when this act becomes law.69

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
