BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 215.10. On August 31, 2021, or as soon as possible 4 thereafter, the Director of Job and Family Services shall 5 certify to the Director of Budget and Management, the President 6 7 and Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, and the Governor, the 8 balance of amounts advanced to the state under section 1201 of 9 the "Social Security Act," 42 U.S.C. 1321. Upon receipt of this 10 certification, the Director of Budget and Management shall remit 11 the amount certified, not to exceed the available balance, from 12 the State Fiscal Recovery Fund (Fund 5CV3) to the Unemployment 13

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Compensation Fund established in section 4141.09 of the Revised 14 Code. The amount of the remittance is hereby appropriated from 15 Fund 5CV3. The amount remitted shall be credited to the 16 Mutualized Account. The Director of Job and Family Services 17 shall deposit as cash the amount remitted with the Secretary of 18 the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the account 19 of this state in the unemployment trust fund established and 20 maintained pursuant to section 904 of the "Social Security Act," 21 42 U.S.C. 1104, to reduce or eliminate the balance of amounts 22 advanced to the state under section 1201 of the "Social Security 23 Act," 42 U.S.C. 1321. 24

On December 27, 2021, or as soon as possible thereafter, 25 the Director of Job and Family Services shall certify to the 26 Director of Budget and Management, the President and Minority 27 Leader of the Senate, the Speaker and Minority Leader of the 28 House of Representatives, and the Governor, the balance of 29 amounts advanced to the state under section 1201 of the "Social 30 Security Act," 42 U.S.C. 1321. Upon receipt of this 31 32 certification, the Director of Budget and Management shall remit the amount certified, not to exceed the available balance, from 33 the State Fiscal Recovery Fund (Fund 5CV3) to the Unemployment 34 Compensation Fund established in section 4141.09 of the Revised 35 Code. The amount of the remittance is hereby appropriated from 36 Fund 5CV3. The amount remitted shall be credited to the 37 Mutualized Account. The Director of Job and Family Services 38 shall deposit as cash the amount remitted with the Secretary of 39 the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the account 40 of this state in the unemployment trust fund established and 41 maintained pursuant to section 904 of the "Social Security Act," 42 42 U.S.C. 1104, to reduce or eliminate the balance of amounts 43 advanced to the state under section 1201 of the "Social Security 44
